Obituary of John Myers John "Frank" Myers, 82, of Ocala passed away on February 3, 2010. Frank was born in Wheeling, West Virginia to Frances and John Myers and as a child also lived in Huntington, West Virginia and Indianapolis, Indiana. He served in the U.S. Navy during WW II as a Seabee and was stationed in Okinawa, Iwo Jima and China. After WW II Frank pursued his childhood passion to a successful career in training and showing horses, a craft he learned from his father who was an internationally acclaimed horseman. After working on the horse show circuit throughout the mid-east U.S., Frank moved to Miami, Florida in the early 1950s and worked for Norris Racing Stables as Farm Manager and trained show horses and trotters and became a sulky driver. Frank married Lois Rack (an accomplished horseman) in 1962 and they moved to Ocala to start Somday Farm, which arose from humble beginnings to become a highly respected thoroughbred horse breeding and training farm. The Myers were early investors in OBS and remain so today. Frank is survived by a son John, Sisters-in-Law Mary Jane Myers and Judith O'Connel, Brother-in-Law Joe Dugan, 8 nieces, 3 nephews, and 15 great nieces/ nephews. He was preceded in death by his devoted wife Lois, his sister Mary Frances (Myers) Dugan, his brother Robert Myers and his parents.
