He cherished traveling with his family to New England and particularly enjoyed Nantucket Island, Ogunquit, ME, Woodstock, VT and the fall foliage of the White Mountains of NH. He was a gourmand, and knew all of the finest restaurants at which to dine, especially in New England. He loved Maine lobster and steamed clams at Barnacle Billys in Ogunquit, ME, and was their most loyal longstanding customer for over 40 years. He will be deeply missed by those who knew and loved him. He is survived by his loving daughters, Darcy A. Raymond Morton of Ocala, FL and Claudette A. Raymond of Kittery, ME; nieces, Marisa Moore
