Obituary of Joseph Wheeler Joseph Anthony Wheeler died of Interstitial Lung Disease, in his Florida home October, 01, 2010, at the age of 75. Formerly of Athens, PA and Nichols, NY., he was born in 1935 in Sayre, PA to Ella McLaughlin Wheeler and Francis Wheeler, whose ancestry traces back to Ireland. He is survived by wife, Marguerite Marie Krapf Wheeler, his children, Linda Marie Wheeler Blackwell, Joseph William Wheeler, Kathleen Susan Wheeler Awad, and Deborah Jean Wheeler Knowlton. Joe Wheeler was known for his generosity and self-effacing ways - he always rooted for the underdog. On his deathbed he recalled all of the people he worked with over the years, and everybody he'd ever met. He requested that his daughter Deborah write a book about his life. Catholic services were held October 06, 2010 in Ocala, Florida and a Memorial service followed.
