Jules "Jay" Winchester, 65, of Ocala, FL went to be with our Lord on Tuesday, January 25, 2022.

Jay was born in Schenectady, NY and then moved to Saratoga Springs, NY where he lived until joining the Navy. While serving in the Navy he lived in Virginia, Scotland, and South Carolina. After his military service he accepted a job with Pneumatic Products in Ocala, FL and stayed with the company for 25 years. For the past 10 years, and up until his passing, he worked at RECO out of Cumming, Georgia.

While living in South Carolina he was a member of Heritage Baptist Church where he served in the bus ministry and participated in the choir. After moving to Ocala he was involved with several churches and for the past 7 years attended Grace United Bible Fellowship. At the time of his passing he was a deacon and also participated in Crossroads, a prison ministry program.

He was the anchor of the family and spent as much time with them as possible. He enjoyed fishing and took his grandkids out on his boat regularly. He liked riding his Harley and was previously involved with BACA (Bikers Against Child Abuse). He was an aquarist and always had multiple fish tanks set up around the house. He enjoyed gardening and grew his own vegetables and also started hydroponic gardening.

Jay leaves to cherish his memory; his wife of 45 years, Jeanne; daughters Heather and Amanda; grandsons Caleb, Kyle, and Kolin, and granddaughters Faith and Ashley. He is preceded in death by his daughter Amy; father Joseph; mother Priscilla, and stepmother, Shirley.

The family will be having a memorial gathering celebrating his life on Saturday, February 26, 2022 at 11:00 AM at Roberts Downtown Chapel with Pastor Ken of Grace United Bible Fellowship. Friends are welcome to attend and celebrate Jay's life with his family. There will also be a live stream of the memorial service.

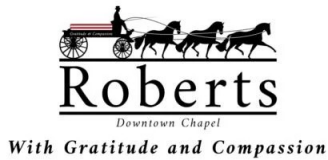
