Kathryn Bond Maryan, of Ocala, Fla., died March 27, 2020 in Ocala at the age of 92. She was born in Jefferson on March 21, 1928 to Willis and Ruth Bond.

A graduate of Cony High School in Augusta, she worked at the Internal Revenue Service in Augusta until 1951 when she transferred to the National Production Authority in Washington, D.C. until their closing. She then joined the Department of Army in Washington, D.C. followed by Fort Sheridan, Ill., retiring in June 1974. Also in Illinois, Kay worked as a receptionist at a doctors office in Waukegan and Abbott Laboratories in North Chicago, retiring in 1986.

Kay loved Maine lobster and spent an hour picking out every bit of meat. When relatives visited her in Florida to help her with household chores, she would say, Leave it! Lets play cribbage.

Kay had an extensive collection of LPs, mostly oldies which she played often. Her favorite performer was Elvis.
