Obituary of Lawrence Finn, Jr. Lawrence Anthony "Larry" Finn, Jr. 73, of Ocala passed away Wednesday, July 1, 2015. He was born to L.A "Huck" and Bernadette Finn on April 3, 1942 in Ocala. Larry graduated from Trinity Academy, Ocala High School, CFCC and Florida State University. After college he entered the US Air Force and served four years at a B-52 SAC Base in California and Okinawa. After the service he returned to Marion County and worked at the Health Department. He became a licensed real estate agent and later worked in the City of Ocala Planning Department until his accident. In 1979, Larry suffered a severe motorcycle accident that left him handicapped. Although he was disabled he continued to live independently until his death. He was a life long member of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. He loved people and had a great wit. He was a good son, brother, uncle and friend. He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his brother, Mike Finn (Diane) of Ocala; sister, Mary B. Cail (Larry) of Jasper, FL; nephews, Michael Finn, Jr. and Stephen Finn of Ocala, David Finn and Brian Walker of Tampa, FL; nieces, Laurel Finn Arnold of High Springs, Jodi Gibson of Jacksonville, FL, Amy Jacobs of Tallahassee, FL; lifelong friends, Freddie and Mary Ellen MacKenzie and children, Ashley and Josh.
