Lolita was the mother of four children, Richard, Suzanne, Jenny and Lisa. She was the grandmother of two granddaughters, Michelle and Kristina, and seven grandsons, Nicholas, Christopher, Kevin, David, Luke, Mark and Michael. Those who knew her well would have observed that she was multi-talented but lived a humble life, and carried a smile with her wherever she went. She was educated by the Ursuline Convent. At that time the Nuns ran a boarding school. This gave her the opportunity to interact with students from all over the world. When she left high school, she continued her education at a business college, while she worked with a subsidiary of the Aluminum Company of Canada. She stayed with that company for 24 years. Lolita and her now deceased husband, Bernhard, worked in California for many years. In 2002 they retired and relocated to Ocala. Lolita was a member of the BTCCW from 2005. After attending the leadership symposium in 2005, she served in the Ave Maria Circle as Spiritual Director for four years. She then served on the Board as Spiritual Director for two years. She also served a short term as Facilitator for Ave Maria Circle. Lolita also attended a few ODCCW Conventions and was an Individual Member of NCCW from 2007 to 2012. She
