Obituary of Lowell Morris Lowell C. Morris Jr., affectionately known to his multitude of friends as "Bud", died peacefully in Ocala, FL on October 21, 2008 at 86 years of age. Bud was born in Bedford, Iowa in 1922, and served as a Captain in the US Army Air Corps, piloting C-47 with the 41st Troop Carrier Squadron, and the 317th Troop Carrier Group during WWII in the Pacific Theater. Bud retired as a manager of the Air Traffic Control Unit in Honolulu, HI and was a member of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Marion County. Bud was preceded in death by his wife of 59 years, Jacquelyn P. Morris. He is survived by his brother, Benjamin B. Morris of St. Louis, MO; son, Lowell C. Morris III of Kansas City, MO; daughter, Patricia P. Morris of Minneapolis, MN; grandsons, Larry C. Morris of Independence, MO and John L. Morris of Hedgesville, WV; and 4 great grandchildren.
