Margaret (Margy) A. Tucker Lamberson, 86, of Ocala, Florida, passed away peacefully on July 27. At her request, no services will be held. A private scattering of her ashes will take place at a future date. Cremation has taken place under the direction of Roberts Funeral Home in Ocala.

Margy was born March 6, 1938, in Sydney Montana to Earl and Clara Tucker. She was the

youngest of six children (Mary Etta Sibert, Betty Nipple, Earl Tucker Jr., Bert Tucker, and

Roberta Jean Wiens) and grew up in Great Falls, MT where she was a faithful member of First

Presbyterian Church, attended Great Falls High School and spent hours ice skating on Gibson

Robert Lamberson, on September 13, 1958. They met playing in the marching band at Great

Falls High School. Together they had four children and settled in Billings, Montana. Margy

loved raising her family, tending to her rose gardens, reading, playing Brady Pitch, and spending

time with her family in the Little Belt Mountains. Once her children started school, Margy

worked in the libraries at Eastern Montana College, Lewis and Clark Junior High and Meridian

Land and Mineral Company.

After Bob's retirement, they moved to White Sulphur Springs, MT. Always the mindful librarian,

Margy donated countless books to the Meagher County Public Library.

Following Bob's

passing, she moved to Billings, MT to be closer to family and then eventually moved to Ocala,

Florida to be near one of her daughters.

Margaret is survived by her three daughters, Kathryn Prah (Doug) of Mesquite, NV, Peggy

Bourne (Rick) of Ocala, FL, and Jamie Agnew (Eric) of Hysham, MT; a son, Paul Lamberson
