Marilyn "Nanny" Lewellyn, 78, of Boonville, Indiana, passed away peacefully on March 8, 2025, in Ocala, Florida.

She graduated from Boonville High School in 1964 and went on to earn her degree in teaching from Murray State University. 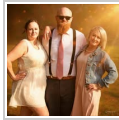
