Marshall Lewis Perez was surrounded by family when he passed away the evening of September 12, 2024 in Ocala, Florida. Marshall battled with cancer, but never stopped fighting as “the warrior”. While we are heartbroken by his departure, we are comforted by the countless memories and laughter he brought into our lives. He had a tee time to get to after all.

Marshall was born in New Orleans, Louisiana on March 7, 1948 to Earnest Raphael Perez Jr and Alice Lewis Williams. He grew up and spent his early life in the New Orleans area where he received a bachelor’s degree in management from Loyola University New Orleans while simultaneously starting his career and a family. Marshall relocated to the Northeast where he received his master’s degree from Gannon University in Erie, PA.
