Mary Lorraine Hendrickson, age 93, of Ocala passed away on December 16th, 2018 at Hospice Legacy House. Born in Streator, IL on July 1st, 1925 Mary was the daughter of Walter T. and Edna (Prendergast) Schmitt. She was happily married for 64 years to her high school sweetheart, Richard (Dick) J. Hendrickson, who preceded her in death in Jan, 2010. Mary graduated from Streator High School in 1943 and received her BS in Nursing from St. Joseph School of Nursing, Bloomington, IL in 1946. She became an RN and devoted 42 years to nursing, working in hospitals and private practices. She and Dick and their twin sons lived in Saudi Arabia during the 1950s, where Dick was employed with Aramco Oil Company. The family returned to the US in 1960 and settled in Singer Island, Florida. In 1996, Mary and Dick moved to On Top of the World in Ocala. They were ardent national and international travelers, traveling to all but one state (North Dakota) and more than 40 countries. Her favorite places were the Pacific Northwest, Northern California, Ireland, New Zealand and the Greek Islands. Since Dick's passing, Mary has lived at On Top of the World, Marian Woods and for the last year at Bridgewater Park Assisted Living. Mary is survived by her loving sons (and daughters-in-law), Dr. Edwin R. (Rene) Hendrickson of Hockessin DE, and Philip W. (Carol) Hendrickson of Martinez, GA. She is also survived by four grandchildren (and spouses), Ashley (Nate) Carlson, Scott (Erin) Hendrickson, Eric (Cara) Hendrickson, and Amy (Josh) Agee. She was also preceded in death by one grandson, Michael J. Hendrickson (2007). Mary is also survived by seven

great-grandchildren, Ryan Carlson, Quinlan and Lila Hendrickson, Mallory and Hayes Hendrickson and Michaela and Caroline Agee. A Celebration of Life will be held at Bridgewater Park Assisted Living Facility on Friday, December 21 at 2:30. Mary's ashes will be interred with Dick's at the Florida National Veteran's Cemetery, Bushnell, FL.
