Mary Shashy Jones passed away on Wednesday July 16, 2014 after a brief illness. Mary was born on December 22, 1928 in Ocala Florida to her parents Fadwa and Samuel Abraham (SA) Moses Shashy. She attended Blessed Trinity Academy and graduated from Ocala High school. After attending business school in Jacksonville Florida, she returned to Ocala to work in the family business, Moses Auto Parts. Mary married Bobby Jones on October 11, 1968. In their later years Mary and Bobby owned and operated Jones Turf Grass Farm in Ft. McCoy, Florida. Mary was a life-long member of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church where she received many awards recognizing her service and devotion to the church and school. Mary's dedication to the youth of Ocala also led her to actively support the Boys and Girls Club of Marion County where she served as secretary for 47 years. She received numerous awards from the Boys and Girls Club including the National Medallion for her unusually devoted service. Other organizations that gave awards to Mary for her community service included the N.A.A.C.P, Ocala Jaycees and the Ocala-Silver Springs Rotary Club. Mary was preceded in death by her parents and husband, and sisters Emilee (Mrs. Warner) Wilson of Ocala and Odette (Mrs. Fred) Shashy of Jacksonville, Fl. She is survived by her two brothers, Dr. S.A.M. (Mitchell) Shashy of Ocala and Dr. Paul Shashy of Montgomery, Al, 17 nieces and nephews, and a large community of beloved family and friends who knew her as Aunt Mary'.
