Obituary of Mary Kallechey Mary Kallechey, 92 passed away Thanksgiving evening at a nursing home in New Hampshire following a long struggle with dementia. Born in Manchester, but raised in Derry, NH, Mary was the third of John and Gianoula Kachavos' seven children. In 1946 she graduated from Keene Teacher's College in NH and began a 30 year career as a Home-Economics teacher and department head. Married to Petro in 1952, they made their home in Concord, NH for next 27 years. In 1979 Petro and Mary retired to Florida, first to Dunnellon later moving to Ocala. Mary was active in the Greek Orthodox Mission of Greater Ocala (now St. Mark's in Belleview) singing in the choir and participating in the church's annual festival. Also, Mary was a senior volunteer and enjoyed reading and scrapbooking. A wonderful cook and hostess, Mary delighted in entertaining family and friends. She returned to New Hampshire in 2009 permanently due to the progression of her dementia. Mary was preceded in death by her husband Petro in 2002 and by brothers, Charles, George and Louis Kachavos and two sisters, Betsy Speros and Demetra Kachavos. She is survived by her son, Tom Kallechey of Manchester, NH and sister, Ernestine Kaliontzis of Arlington, Massachusetts, and many nieces and nephews. Also, Tom's Goddaughter Margaret Guy and her brother Daniel Guy and sister Monica Savoie all of Nashua to whom Mary was their Yia Yia.
