Mary Frances Metzger, also known as Mary Hunter Metzger, age 90, moved from Pt. St. Lucie, Florida in May of 2023 to then reside in Ocala, Florida with her daughter and son-in-law. Mary passed away on March 23, 2024 at Life Care Center in Ocala, Florida.

Mary was born in Washington D.C. to James A. Hunter and Olive Jeannette Hunter on July 8, 1933. When she was in 5th grade, Mary, along with her brother Jimmy Hunter, her parents, and her paternal grandmother Hunter (Nana) moved from Kenilworth in Washington D.C. to North Miami, Florida on a train.
