Melvin E. "Mel" Carpenter, 84, of Ocala passed away April 13, 2016. Born in Albemarle, NC, he came to this area over 60 years ago from Mississippi. He received his Bachelors and Masters Degrees from the University of Southern Mississippi and took Advanced Studies at the University of Florida. Mel was a retired teacher, coach and athletic director for Central Florida Community College and United Methodist by faith. Among his many notable achievements include mentoring and being a role model to the many student athletes he lead in his long career, with over a dozen former athletes becoming head coaches at other colleges. Mel was inducted into the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College Athletics Hall of Fame, the National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame, and lead CFCC to three national tennis championships. He is survived by his wife of 63 years, Etta; daughters, Kim (Darrell) Newman of Madison, MS, Kelly (Anthony) Asquith of Ocala, Dayna (Henry) Priest of Winter Park, FL, Kris Carpenter of Ocala, and Mary Key Priest (John) Gerlach of Orlando; grandchildren, Justin Newman, Kyle Newman, Savannah Newman, Etta Priest, Camille Priest and Camp Priest; and cousin-brother Alton Broadway of Concord, NC.
