Obituary of Michael Nanartowicz Mr. Michael Stanley Nanartowicz, 81 of Ocala, Florida passed away on Monday, April 2, 2007 at Munroe Regional Medical Center, Ocala. Mike was born on Sunday, March 21, 1926 in Shenandoah, Pennsylvania to Andrew and Aemlie (Stanczyk) Nanartowicz. He retired as a machine operator and relocated to Marion County in 1980 from Jackson, New Jersey. Michael "Mickey" Nanartowicz served his country during World War II and Korea, reaching the rank of Tech. Sergeant. It was during the Korean War that he was captured and held for thirty-three months as a Prisoner of War. Mike was a parishioner at Our Lady of the Springs Catholic Church, Silver Springs, Florida, a member of the DAV and the Association of Ex-POWs of the Korean War, Inc. He enjoyed woodworking, fishing, and boating. He was also lovingly referred to around the house as "Mr. Fix-it". Michael S. Nanartowicz is survived by his wife of fifty-three years, Kay H. Nanartowicz of Ocala, FL daughters, Kathy Lee Armstrong of Ocean, N.J., Michele Ingling and her husband Lloyd Jr. of Toms River, N.J., Frances Russo and her husband Michael Jr. of Jackson, N.J., Susan R. Pepe and her husband William of Belleview, FL, sons Stanley Nanartowicz and his wife Mary of Westowne, N.Y. and Michael Nanartowicz Jr. and his wife Margaret of Jackson, N.J.
