Milagros Dino Jamora or who was fondly called Mila, beloved mother and grandmother, passed away on Monday December 1, 2025, in Ocala, Florida at the age of 82.

Milagros was born on February 1, 1943 to Romualdo Dino and Salud Constantino in Sorsogon, Philippines. Milagros was an Elementary teacher, who was married to Renato J Jamora, a US NAVY veteran (deceased). Together they raised their family moving from San Diego CA to settle in Norfolk, Virginia.
