Obituary of Nicholas Chillemi
Nicholas A. Chillemi Sr., 89, of Ocala, passed away Feb. 20, 2010 in his home with his family at his side. Born in New York City he came to this area in 1977 from Orlando, FL where he worked as the head PGA golf professional at Silver Springs Shores CC. He was a 20 year veteran of the Army Air Corps / USAF serving in World War II and Korea and retiring as a Master Sergeant. Teaching his love of golf to his children he produced three professionals. Mr. Chillemi accomplished the Fourth Degree in the Knights of Columbus, and was a member of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. He was preceded in death by his wife Luise, son John, and granddaughter Amonda Chillemi.
