Norbert John Scully II, 79, of Ocala, FL passed away peacefully on October 15, 2025 surrounded by his family.

Born in Evergreen Park, Illinois, Norbert grew up between Chicagoland and Florida before traveling the world as an Interior Communications Electrician Fireman Apprentice in the United States Navy, where he proudly served on the USS Independence (CVA-62).
