Obituary of Percival ChadwickPercival A. Chadwick, 94, of Ocala, passed away on September 30, 2015. Born in Bridgeport, CT, he has been a resident of Ocala since 1999. He was a veteran of the US Army Air Corp and held the rank of Sergeant. Mr. Chadwick was a nose gunner on a B-24 Liberator, one of the most famous heavy bombers of World War II, in which he flew 34 missions. On one mission his plane was shot down and he spent 6 months as a POW in Romania. Mr. Chadwick was retired from General Electric after 34 years. He was an avid sailor and enjoyed golfing. He also coached boys and girls basketball and girls softball.He is survived by his loving wife of 67 years, Margaret Chadwick of Ocala; sons, David Arthur (Vicky) Chadwick of Merritt Island, FL and John Thomas Chadwick of Milford, CT; his daughter, Diane Helen (Peter) Fowler of Carry, NC; sister, Ann Carmichael of Milford, CT; 8 grandchildren, 14 great grandchildren, and 1 great great grandson.
