Peter S. Pallitto, 83, passed away, after an 8 month illness on July 3rd in Ocala, Florida.

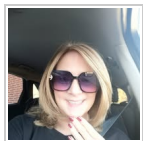

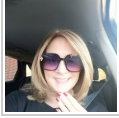
