Obituary of Raymond Christian Mr. Ray Lee Christian Jr. passed away on July 8, 2012 after a lengthy battle with cancer. He was born in West Palm Beach, FL on September 3, 1933. He attended elementary school in Pahokee, and junior and high school at Florida Military Academy in St. Petersburg. After graduation he spent four years in the Air Force, serving in Japan and Indochina. When his career with the service ended, he returned to school first earning his Bachelor Degree in Engineering from the University of Florida and then a Masters Degree from North Carolina State. While earning his master degree he was hired by Bell Laboratories and continued to work for them in North Carolina and then later in South Florida. After sixteen years with the labs, he decided to go into business and started Engine Rebuilders Warehouse in Ft. Lauderdale. In 2000 Ray sold the business and retired to Ocala, Florida. Ray had many interests: sailing, flying, motorcycling and photography. He was an avid gator fan from a very young age and stuck with them through thick and thin. He is survived by his wife Doris of sixty years (childhood sweetheart); Three children: Mike Christian, Pam Wiggins and her husband Michael, Cathy Poling and her husband Terry; Eight grandchildren: John, Brandon, Brett, Troy, Shane, Brooke, Maggie and Skyler.
