Rev. Harry Pratts, 66 of Dunnellon, Fl. passed away on June 22nd 2019 in Ocala, FL.

Harry was born in Brooklyn, NY to Antonio Pratts and Blanca Rosa Rodriguez on July 31st 1952. In 1966 he graduated from Franklin Delano Roosevelt High School in Brooklyn, NY. 1984 he received an Associate Degree in Sacred Literature from Logos Bible College, in 1996 he secured his Bachelor of Arts in Theological Studies from Vision Christian College. He went on to earn a Masters Degree in Theology from Vision International University 1996.

He served our country for thirty-four years, and retired as a Chief Master Sergeant from the United States Air Force.

He was a fervent student and reader of The Word of God, the Bible. He enjoyed reading, running, playing basketball and writing. He authored two books Standing Against The Wiles Of The Enemy, We Need The Holy Spirit and the accompanying workbook. His blog Coffee With A Straw was an encouragement to many. He was the Academic Dean at Casa Hope.
