Obituary of Richard Bonnett Richard Clay Bonnett, 93, of Summerfield, FL, passed away October 2nd at his home. Born in Akron, Ohio, he and his late wife Evelyn Radanof came to this area in 1990 from Kimbolton, Ohio. Mr. Bonnett was a retired Senior Account Agent for Allstate Insurance. He began his military career in the Ohio National Guard as a member of the cavalry. He was an Army Veteran of WWII and served in the 687th Ordnance Ammunition Unit in Italy from 1942 until the end of the war. Following the war, he completed his college degree in business at Akron University. He was a 32nd degree Mason and member of the Freeport Lodge #415, Ohio, Scottish Rite Valley of Cambridge, Ohio and the Morocco Shrine in Jacksonville, FL. He was also in the Eastern Star, Freeport, Ohio #319. An accomplished concert violinist, he played in the Doctors Orchestra in Akron and Central Florida Symphony in Ocala. He was a member of the American Quarter Horse Assoc. and the Turf Club. He was married to Evelyn Mae Radanof for 65 years who died in 2001. Survivors include his sons, Thomas R. Bonnett of Baltimore, MD and William C. Bonnett of Sterling, OH; sister, Marjorie B. Saffel of Spring Hill, FL; 7 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild.
