Obituary of Richard Doyle Richard W. Doyle, 83, passed away January 22, 2011 at Munroe Regional Medical Center. He was born in Easton, PA to Russell and Olive Doyle. He worked for Mack Printing Co in Wilson, PA for over 42 years as Head Pressman on the high speed web press. He enlisted in the U. S. Navy at age 17 and was assigned to the USS Fitch as a mine sweeper and anti aircraft gunner during WWII in the South Pacific. He was present at the Japanese Surrender Signing Ceremony. After serving 4 years. At the start of the Korean War he reenlisted in the Navy and served two additional years on the recommissioned USS Hambleton DMS-20, a high speed destroyer. He served as an engine and boiler operator. During his military service he received metals and ribbons.
