Obituary of Robert Bielarski Robert Vincent Bielarski, Ph.D., 86, died on November 29, 2015 at Legacy House in Ocala, Florida due to complications from a recent illness. Born August 2, 1929, in Linden, NJ, he was the son of the late Philip and Helen (Pinkerous) Bielarski. He graduated from Linden High School, and continued his education at St. Bonaventure University (New York), Louisiana State University, Centenary College of Louisiana, and Rutgers University in New Jersey. Robert V. "Bob" Bielarski joined the US Army where he served as a Lieutenant in the Korean War, and later attained the rank of Major in the US Army Reserves. In 1959 he earned his PhD. in Entomology and Plant Pathology from Rutgers University. After owning a pest control business in Woodbridge, NJ, he taught geology at Rider College in Trenton, NJ. He later became the chairman of the math and science department at Frederick Community College in Frederick, MD. From the late 1970s, he worked for the Department of the Navy where he traveled extensively, and finished his career with the EPA in 1997. At that time he moved to Ocala, FL, where he became an active member of the Oak Run Community and a volunteer funeral escort with the Marion County Sheriff's Office for 10 years. Bob is survived by his loving and devoted wife of over 50 years, Mary T. (Burke) Bielarski of Ocala, and 3 sons: Philip of Williamsport, MD, Robert of Camp Hill, PA, and Steven of New York, NY, along with 3 grandchildren.
