Obituary of Robert Chittenden Chittenden, Robert J. of Ocala, Florida, passed away Jan. 5, 2011. He was born June 7, 1924 to Joel and Evangelina Chittenden in Linn, Kansas. One year later they moved to Madison, Wisconsin. Robert attended schools in Madison, WI - graduating from High School in 1942. He also attended some college in New York. Robert suffered injuries as a WWII combat infantry man in the Battle of the Bulge and the Ardennes Campaign. He was awarded the Purple Heart & Bronze Star medals, Combat Infantry Badge and other military recognition including two campaign ribbons with battle stars. He was employed by the State of Wisconsin at desk work from Oct. 1946 through Feb. 1981. He was a cartographer and registered for the processing technical/legal review of the Wisconsin land subdivision plats and assessor's plats, i.e. Wisconsin's System for Land division into building lots. He is a life member of the Order of the Purple Heart, DAV and VFW Post 4209 of Ocala, FL. Survivors include his wife Geraldine of Ocala, FL; Sons - James Randall, daughter Linda of Madison, WI and son Michael of Minnesota. Many grandchildren and great grandchildren in Madison, WI; 1 stepson Jack Behrend & Shirley, Ocala, FL; 1 step grandson Thomas of Reedsburg, WI; 2 step great granddaughters of Reedsburg, WI; 1 sister Mary Anderson of Madison, WI.
