Obituary of Robert Schmidt Former Vermont resident, Robert (Bob) Winfred Schmidt, 81, died February 26, 2013, at Legacy House in Ocala, FL. Bob was born on 20 September 1931 in Chicago Illinois to Dorothy M. Schmidt and Winfred H. Schmidt. He graduated from White Plains, NY in 1951. He joined the United States Navy during the Korean War and served four years on LST 1166. He attended SUNY in Delhi, NY, where he met and married Shirley Warfel in 1956. After graduating they bought a farm in Vermont and raised three sons. He was awarded outstanding Conservation Farmer of the year in 1966. After retiring in 1994 they moved to Ocala, FL where they pursued golf and his hobby of stamp collecting. He is survived by his loving and devoted wife of 56 years Shirley, Robert David Schmidt and his wife, Barbara Ann Schmidt from Alexandria, VA; Steven Fred Schmidt from Piermont, NH; John Carl Schmidt from Salt Lake City, Utah, and 2 grandsons, Derek Robert Schmidt and his wife, Alicia Schmidt from Staten Island, NY and Ethan Schmidt from Kings Point, NY.
