Robert J. "Bob" Tudor, 70, of Ocala, FL, passed away peacefully at home on September 27, 2018. Born on June 25, 1948 in Baltimore, MD to his proud parents, Charles and Marie (Busick) Tudor, Bob was retired from the U.S. Air Force after 20 years, then worked for NASA, GSA, NOA and the Census Bureau, where he was the operations property manager. In 1984, Bob was named Outstanding Young Man of America and worked under President Reagan. He was NCO of the year in 1977-78, Administrator of the Year in 1976 and Instructor of the Year in 1977. He was in the Civil Air Patrol from 1984-1988 and received the Bronze Award from the Census Bureau Department of Commerce. He also spent time helping a missionary in Uganda. Bob loved to tell jokes and spend his day fishing. He was preceded in death by his parents, his sister, Helen Tudor and his brother John Tudor.
