Obituary of Salvador Patino Salvador (Pat) Patino of Ocala, Florida, passed away in his sleep on February 14, 2010 at 99 years of age. Born in Guanajuato, Mexico on December 3, 1910, Pat traveled to Chicago at age 18 and then to New Jersey, combining studies and work. He took great pride in his American citizenship. He had a long and varied career with Sterling Drug Pharmaceuticals, Int'l., heading their Accounting Departments in various countries including Peru and Chile and setting up offices in Italy, Spain and Portugal.
