SHASHY, DR. S.A. MOSES "MITCHELL" Ocala - Dr. S.A. Moses "Mitchell" Shashy, 91, passed away Friday, May 13, 2016 in the comfort of his home surrounded by family. Born and raised in Ocala, Mitchell attended Blessed Trinity Academy and graduated from Ocala High School. He was the oldest of five children and is preceded in death by parents S. A. Moses and Fadwa Shashy; three sisters, Emily Wilson, Odette Shashy, Mary Jones, and grandson Samuel Hutto. He received his medical degree from Emory University and completed a residency in Urology at Jackson Memorial Hospital in Miami. He returned to his hometown in 1956 to become Ocala's first urologist where he thoroughly enjoyed a successful and fulfilling practice of 32 years, retiring in 1988. He genuinely loved all people, bringing smiles, jokes and laughter wherever he went. Mitchell was a lifelong member of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. He was an avid and skilled hunter and fisherman, and enjoyed many hobbies throughout his full life, especially his oil paintings since retirement. Completely devoted to his family, he is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Mildred "Millie" Shashy; son, Sam Shashy, daughters; Linda Hutto (David), Mary Seibert (Grant) and Diane Masin (Don) seven grandchildren, six great grandchildren, brother Dr. Paul M.
