Obituary of Shreeram Dixit Shreeram Dixit was born in Pune, India September 23rd 1943. His parents, Mr. Krishna D Dixit and Mrs. Nirmala K Dixit along with his elder brother Dr. Narendra K Dixit welcomed Shreeram in his ancestral home in 130 Budhwar. He had a large family consisting of paternal and maternal uncles, aunts as well as a slew of cousins, who doted on him till the very end. His schooling consisted of stints in Ornella's in Pune, Don Bosco in Bombay and Delhi Public School in Delhi. This was a direct result of his father being posted in various cities as he worked with All India Radio, and was a noted literary critic and an award winning writer himself. He completed his baccalaureate in St. Xavier's College in Bombay, followed by a Master's in Pune University focusing on Economics and Political Science. He worked with Kirloskar's and in Telco for 30 years. He finally retired, as he and his family migrated to the United States in May 1996. He lived a semi-retired life in Mansfield Ohio and Ocala Florida thoroughly enjoying his golden years. He did suffer some medical setbacks which he took in his stride and made sure he maintained his independence till the very end. He was fiercely proud of that very fact. He is survived by Mrs. Hemlata S Dixit, Kanaka S Dixit, Kaustubh Dixit, Dr. Shrinivas Atreya, Atharva Atreya and Arhan Atreya.
