Obituary of Theodore George Theodore Glen George, 85, of Ocala, Florida, passed away February 12, 2009. He was born December 26, 1923, in Tuscola, Illinois, the son of the late Walter D. and Ava Murphey George. He married the late Margaret Harding George in Indianapolis, Indiana on July 8, 1945. He is survived by 3 children, Mrs. Cheryl K. Casey and husband Bill of Ocala, FL, Miss Annette George of Chiang Mai, Thailand and Richard W. George of Myrtle Beach, SC; sister, Mrs. Doris Donaldson of Milwaukee, WI. He was preceded in death by 2 brothers and one sister. Mr. George served in the US Army Air Corps in the US and England during WWII from 1943-1945. He graduated from Purdue University with a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering in 1950. Mr. and Mrs. George lived in Columbus, IN where he worked for Cummins Engine Company for 29 years. He was an Eagle Scout and a Scoutmaster for many years. He served as deacon and elder of First Presbyterian Church of Columbus, IN and a charter member and elder of Fairlawn Presbyterian Church in Columbus. Mr. and Mrs. George moved to Myrtle Beach in July of 1984. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and AARP, where he was a volunteer for the tax assistance program. He served many years at Associated Charities and moved to Ocala, FL in November of 2007. A Memorial Service at First Presbyterian Church will be held at a later date. Burial of ashes will be in Forest Hill Cemetery, Shelbyville, IN.
