



Theodore Ronald Norris

March 4, 1933 - October 23, 2022

Theodore R. Norris, 89, passed away the morning of Sunday, October 23, 2022. He was born in Mt. Kisco, NY in 1933. His father Wilber L. Norris was a Civil Engineer and worked for the U.S. Engineer Department in Panama. Ted graduated from Balboa High School in Panama in 1953. He was very athletic and played football, ran track, pole vaulted, boxed and bowled. After graduation his family returned to the States. Ted joined the U.S. Marine Corps in August 1953 during the Korean conflict and separated August 1956 with an Honorable Discharge. Shortly thereafter he met his soon to be wife, Patricia (Patsy) L. Linton. They were married May 20, 1957 in Arlington, VA. In 1958 Ted started working for the U.S. Postal Service as a Letter Carrier and retired 30 years later on April 1, 1988. During this time Ted was introduced to motorcycles by his nephew James and he enjoyed riding. He belonged to the Venture Touring Society and attended many events and made many friends along the way. These trips took him into 46 of the contiguous states, all but Washington and Oregon. During a trip to Ocala, FL he found a house and told Patsy they were moving as he was tired of the cold and snow in VA. So, they moved in October 1991 and resided there until Patsy & passing in June 2015. They were married for 58 years. At this time it was learned that Ted was suffering from Alzheimer & and was moved into a nursing home in FL and later moved back to VA to be near family.
