Thomas Joseph Colantino, age 91, of Ocala, Florida died Thursday, April 18, 2019 at West Marion Community Hospital. Funeral memorial will be held at Roberts Funeral Home West Chapel, 6241 SW State Road 200, Ocala, on Saturday, April 27, 2019 from 11:00-1:00 PM with a memorial service taking place at noon.
