Thurman Randall Greene, a devoted husband, father, and provider passed away on November 19, 2025 at the age of 88.

Randall was born in Sutton, West Virginia to Ralph and Maimie Green. He attended Sutton High School and was a Letterman on the football team as well as a Who's Who.
