MSG (retired) Victor William "Bill" Smith, Jr., a retired mechanic for the Department of Military Affairs and Master Sargent for the Florida Army National Guard and lifelong resident of Ocala, Florida. Bill passed away at home with his family at his side on Tuesday, December 24th, 2019 at the age of 70 after a courageous yearlong battle with ALS. Bill was preceded in death by both parents.
