Obituary of William Doss William A. "Bill" Doss Sr., age 78, of Salt Springs, FL, passed away Friday, 10/11/2013 in Ocala, FL. He was a charter member of 82nd Airborne Division Association of The North Central FL All Airborne chapter.
