Obituary of Wilma Schild Active, competitive, loving and proud, Wilma B. Schild died Sunday, Aug. 23, 2015 at age 89, forcing her twice-weekly golf foursome to cancel its scheduled tee time. Funeral services for Wilma, a resident of New Port Richey, FL., who previously resided in Ocala, FL., and Tracy City, Tenn., will be held Thursday, Aug. 27, at Roberts Funeral Home, 606 SW 2nd Ave., Ocala. Viewing is scheduled from 9:30 to 11AM, followed by the Funeral Service and interment at Forest Lawn Memory Gardens. Wilma was an inspiration to all who knew and admired her. Born June 8, 1926 and raised on a farm in Coffee County, Tenn., she was the third oldest in a family of six daughters and two sons, played girls high school basketball and softball and forever carried an active, outgoing spirit through life. Along with working 21 years for the City of Ocala Utilities Department, before retiring in 1999, Wilma was a multiple Florida State women's champion in muzzle-loading rifle shooting competition, an active water skier, performed in a clogging dance group, and finally, after moving to New Port Richey for retirement, took golf lessons and immediately embraced the game. Other life accomplishments include membership in Eastern Star, extensive Hospice volunteer activity, a membership in the Trinity Lutheran Church and a passion for cruise ship vacations. Love for family and friends, however, was always Wilmas top priority. She is survived by sons Mick Elliott and Randy Schild, daughters-in-law Desanya Daly and Shelly Schild, all in Safety Harbor, Fl., sisters Bonnie Phillips (Gainesville) and Faye Mossman (Ocala) and 11 nieces and nephews.
